I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:39 p.m. In attendance were Neal Stevenson, Missy Yearwood, Dr. John McNeill, Dr. Larry Gajewskey, Jennifer Southern, Lucy Ortega, Jason Ohrt, Keri Wickliffe, Alyssa Tinsley, Melissa Karnei, Addie Bell, Heather Taylor, Rhonda Talkington, Alyssa Villarreal, and Herb Spencer.

II. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

1. March 20, 2023

Dr. McNeill made the motion to approve the March 20, 2023 minutes as presented. Missy Yearwood the second. The vote was unanimously approved.

Keri Wickliffe began by providing an update regarding the Victoria County Appraisal District and her role in the VCAD. She presented facts regarding various sectors of the VCAD to include: Residential 20 to 60% increase; Land, 25 to 40% increase, and 30% increase in small acreage; Commercial 30 to 60% increase; Soft Landing regarding the economy.

Mrs. Southern announced that Alyssa Villarreal and Connie Boedecker were the employees of the Month for their hard work and dedication to NISD. Currently, NISD has 133 students. We have had an influx of 10 new students but then 4 left. This happens a lot at NISD. This year, NISD will implement a Transfer Committee to review transfer applications.

Dr. Gajewskey reported that Spring Fling was a success and many thanks to PTO for their efforts. May 19 with be NISD's Field Day and we will likely open this up to parents at the end of the day as we did last year. Dr. Gajewskey had the opportunity to take the SBOE Representative, LJ Francis, on a tour of NISD. Dr. Gajewskey explained the challenges that NISD continues to face regarding the financial issues that negatively impact NISD and our school community. LJ Francis was very receptive and listened attentively. Dr. Gajewskey reported that the Safety and Security EOP was accepted by the State with no additional changes. Finally, Dr. Gajewskey applied for the SRSA grant and is awaiting approval from the State.

- Dr. Gajewskey previously sent the Board the EOP and Annexes; Neal Stevenson made the motion to approve the EOP and Annexes. Missy Yearwood made the Second. The vote carried unanimously.

Consider and Approve the 2023-2024 Allotment and TEKS Certification form Information was discussed regarding the new requirements for a Stand-Alone Phonics Program, NISD currently has a solid Reading Program that addresses the needs of all children. Dr. Gajewskey stated that more research was needed but he would make the best decision for the students at NISD. Missy Yearwood made the motion to approve the 2023-2024 TEKS Certification as presented. Neal Stevenson, made the second but added that Dr. Gajewskey could select a program from the approved programs but also has the authority to not select from the recommended list. The vote was unanimous.

Neal Stevenson made the motion to grant Dr. Gajewskey the authority to offer contracts as NISD prepares for the 2023-2024 school year. Missy Yearwood made the second. The vote carried unanimously.
